

## **VOTER INFORMATION:**

### **REQUIREMENTS TO VOTE IN THE TOWN OF PORT WASHINGTON:**

- Must be a citizen of the United States of America
- Must be 18 years of age
- Must be a resident of the Town of Port Washington for at least 28 consecutive days before any election
- Must be registered to vote in the Town of Port Washington, and;
- Must provide a PHOTO IDENTIFICATION

### **VOTER REGISTRATION:**

Anyone wishing to vote in the Town of Port Washington is required to register, and have four options to register: Go to <https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/>



**BY MAIL:** Download the [Application for Voter Registration \(EL-131\)](#). Complete the form and mail it into the municipal clerk's office up 20 days before the election. Mail to the Town Hall, 3715 Highland Drive, Port Washington WI 53074. (after the 20th day before the election you must register in person). You will need to provide a proof of residence document with your registration.

**IN PERSON:** Register at the town hall office through the Friday prior to the election. If you are registering in person, you will need to provide a proof of residence document.

**AT THE POLLING PLACE:** You can register to vote on Election Day at the polls. You will need to provide a proof of residence document. All Proof of Residence documents must include the voters name and current address.

### **ABSENTEE VOTING:**

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, and who has resided in the Town for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

To register online:



You must make a request for an absentee ballot in writing. Contact the municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the election. You may also submit a written request in the form of a letter or email. Your written request must list your voting address within the town, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature. You may make application for an absentee ballot by mail or in person.

The deadline for making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is 5 days before the election.

You may also request and vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office. The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office will be published and posted prior to the election. The last day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is the Friday before the election.

## **POLLING PLACE & HOURS**

The official polling place for the residents of the Town of Port Washington is located at the Town Hall, 3715 Highland Drive, Port Washington. The polls are open from 7:00 AM until 8:00 PM on election day.
