Official Minutes from the Public Hearing of the Town of Port Washington Town Board was held on
Monday, August 2, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall, 3715 Highland Drive,
Port Washington, WI.

1. Roll Call:

2. Consideration of a request for Jean A Greiveldinger, Richard Greiveldinger applicant to rezone the property at 3611 county Road B, which is approximately 1.7 acres from A-1 to R-2. The new 1.7-acre lot will separate the existing home from the remainder of the property which will be 41.8 acres. Per Didier, this has been approved by the Plan Commission.

John Taucher, 2083 Upper Ridge Road; is there proposed housing for this land? What are the height restrictions on this? Didier; this is a rezone of the 1-7-acre parcel only, not the remaining 41 acres.

At this time, there are no plans for that parcel, which is zoned A-1. Single family homes have a height restriction of 45 feet.

Bob Jackson informed the board that he has spoken to Craig Heatwole regarding the Heatwole foundry, located behind the town hall. Mr. Heatwole would be willing to sell the foundry to the town, which also has a 10" high capacity well on the property. Jackson has contacted the City Engineer and a private firm and this well would be able to serve town residents. Jackson urges the board to look into this, it would be another option of brining water and sewer into the town rather down Groeschel Road.
