

## 2010 REAL ESTATE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS

Your property tax bill has tear-off stubs for payment installments. If mailing payments please include stub with your check made out to Port Washington Town Treasurer. **DO NOT** mail back the actual bill.

\*Please send self-addressed, stamped envelope along with your payment if you would like a receipt.

You may make payments during lobby hours at the PWSB— Port branch and Harris Bank- Port branch. If you have a refund coming and want the refund immediately payment at the banks is suggested. If you pay by mail or in person at the Town Hall refunds will be mailed within two weeks.

In -person payments can be made during special Town Hall tax collection hours.
